

CONSERVATION GRADE

Conservation grade is intended and suited for planting shelterbelts, erosion control, windbreaks, wildlife habitat and other conservation purposes. Conservation stock is graded mainly on the merits of its possible survival with less consideration to deficiencies which may detract from its value in the ornamental nursery trade. Size may vary, although extremes are not normally included within the same bundle. Availability of this grade for some species may be limited if most of the crop meets the higher standards set for other grades. Shrub sizes designated 18+ will be topped at 18".

Orders for conservation grade will be shipped after we have finished our winter grading and the final availability is known. Advise us when you order if you will accept substitutions of our normal grade at the higher price should conservation grade be unavailable.
